



Sheffield Fruit Trees



Cherries and Damsons

Bramburo Cherry

Large, deep-red sweet cherries, grafted from a tree which reliably crops heavily in Sheffield.

Crops toward end of July.

Colt rootstock grows to a 4 – 5 metre tree; Gisela 5 rootstock grows to about 3 metres by 5 years, but needs permanent staking or training against a wall. Consider netting to get any before the birds do!

Merryweather Damson

Widely grown – grows well in cool temperate climate.

Extremely hardy tree. Disease resistant. Large fruit for damson, reliable crops of typical blue skinned, yellow fleshed quite acidic tasting fruit. Crops late August. Great for making jam. Self-fertile.

Shropshire Prune Damson

Rather small but very flavoursome damson, prized for making preserves / wines owing to its flavour.

Hardy tree. Crops September.
