Pears and Quince

“Brambles” Pear

This heavy cropping, hardy tree produces juicy, delicate flavoured fruits. The parent tree this is taken from bears the full assault of the prevailing winds from its spot on a Sheffield hill top, but calmly continues to produce its delicious, long storing fruits un-phased. Not unlike modern 'Invincible' variety.

Spiral Pear

A Sheffield abundance favourite - propagated from hard-won cuttings! The old, mature pear tree in the west of Sheffield from which this originates is well over 100 years old and has a spiral trunk. It's delicious, juicy fruits boast an almond hinted flavour, and blush to a delicate pink in sunlight. We once picked over 500 kgs from the parent tree!
A genuine Sheffield gem.

Sharrow Quince

A smell to make your mouth water if ever there was one. These large, bright yellow, pear shaped fruits are particularly fragrant. The dense fruits need cooking to enjoy, and there are so many wonderful baking and preserving uses for them.
